

Cascades Raptor Center – Service Animal Policy

Service animals are not allowed in most guest areas on-site, due to the fact that service animals are natural predators of the birds in our care and would make them dangerously agitated. For the birds' safety and well-being, service animals are not allowed in any area that is within sight of a bird in an aviary.

With advanced notice and coordination, a guest with a registered service animal can schedule a private program or one-one-one in the Education Pavilion located directly adjacent to the parking lot. Individuals with service animals may call education staff at (541) 485-1320. In these cases, the service animal's movement must be restricted to the designated location and cannot go near bird aviaries. Availability is dependent on bird comfort and the particular situation.
